Equality (7,5 hp)

In this course we will look at the philosophical arguments behind the idea that inequalities between individuals are bad. We will analyse what sort of inequalities we should be interested in—i.e., of income, of status, of capacities, etc.—whether inequality is bad for society and what are the costs of redistribution; what is the role of desert for determining which inequalities are unfair; what are the rival distributive principles to Equality, etc.
